Methodology and summary of findings



Methodology: polling

J.L. Partners polled two audiences in conjunction with Number Cruncher: a nationally representative sample of British Muslims and a nationally representative sample of the general public.

- Fieldwork dates of 14th February 12th March 2024 for British Muslims, 4th 6th March 2024 for General Public
- Sample of 1,000 for British Muslims, 2,013 for General Public
- Quotas were added to ensure representative data for each sample:
 - Age, gender, education, ethnic group, country of birth and region for the British Muslim Sample
 - Age, gender, ethnicity, region, and 2019 vote for General Public Sample
- Each sample was weighted back to its own representative population using ONS data:
 - Using age, gender, education, ethnic group, country of birth and region for the British Muslim Sample
 - Using age, gender, ethnicity, region, and 2019 vote for General Public Sample
- Sample collected using online panel
- 10-minute duration
- Margin of error: 3.1% for Muslims, 2.2%

Key stats: political behaviour

- British Muslims think it is more acceptable than not to **protest outside an MP's office** if they disagreed with them on Israel/Palestine, and that an **MP should be removed**
 - 44% find removal of an MP on other side of the Israel/Palestine argument to them acceptable, with only 18% finding it unacceptable
- Broadly Muslims do not find it acceptable to protest outside an MP's home
 18-34s are an exception
- Almost half of British Muslims say **Jews have too much power over UK government policy**. This rises to 53% amongst male Muslims
 - This is similar for **US foreign policy**
 - Four in ten say this is the case for the **UK financial system**
 - $\circ~$ Four in ten say this is the case for the **UK media industry**
- One in four British Muslims name the **Israel/Palestine co**nflict as their most important election issue compared to just 3% of the public
 - But the **cost of living** is most important overall to British Muslims (40%)

Key stats: Israel/Palestine

- Only one in four British Muslims believe Hamas committed murder and rape in Israel on October 7th
- Only one in four British Muslims believe Israel has a right to exist as a Jewish homeland
- Almost half of British Muslims feel more sympathy with Hamas than Israel
 53% of 18-34 year old Muslims; they are the most likely to sympathise with Hamas
- Muslims are more likely to have a positive than a negative view of **Hamas**; only 24% have a negative view of Hamas
- More than half of British Muslims believe the BBC is biased towards Israel
- While the wider public are more likely to believe **Hamas wanted to kill Jews on October 7th** (40% to 26%) more than half of British Muslims say it was to **forward the Palestinian cause** (52% to 11%)

Key stats: Future of society

- 63% of British Muslims want rooms for public prayer in non-religious places (such as non-faith schools and hospitals)
- 65% want to **make Eid-al-Fitr a public holiday** (compared to just 21% of the public)
- 57% want compulsory use of Halal food in all schools and hospitals
- 52% want to **make it illegal to show a picture of the Prophet Mohammed** (compared to just 16% of the public)
- Only 16% say it would be undesirable to have **a Muslim political party** (compared to 53% of the public)
- Only 23% say it would be undesirable to have **Islam declared national religion** (compared to 61% of the public)
- Only 23% say it would be undesirable to have **Sharia Law** (compared to 60% of the public)


- Only 17% think it is undesirable that **women take a more traditional role in society**
- Only 27% say it would be undesirable to outlaw gay marriage (compared to 60% of the wider public)
- Only 28% say it would be undesirable to **outlaw homosexuality in the UK** (compared to 62% of the public as a whole)
- Only 26% say it would be undesirable to **outlaw abortion**, compared to 63% of the public as a whole
- Only 35% say it would be undesirable to **legalise polygamy**, compared to 70% of the public


Six in ten British Muslims say they would vote Labour compared to 43% of the general public

Labour is retaining seven in ten of its vote amongst British Muslims compared to 2019


Which party would you vote for if there was a General Election tomorrow?

Imagine your MP were to have a totally different stance to you regarding the Israel/Palestine conflict. Which of the following are acceptable or unacceptable in the circumstances?























Female Muslims and younger Muslims are most likely to have a positive view of Hamas




More than half of British Muslims believe the BBC is biased towards Israel

While the wider public are more likely to believe Hamas wanted to kill Jews on October 7th, more than half of British Muslims say it was to forward the Palestinian cause


Which of the following statements comes closest to your view in explaining why Hamas attacked Israel on October 7th?









Do you feel that the implementation of the following in the UK in the next 20 years would be desirable or undesirable?



What best describes your view on the impact of cultural diversity in Britain?








Eight in ten are concerned about extremist beliefs in the UK

How concerned, if at all, are you over extremist beliefs in the UK?




Concern about Islamist extremism is the highest

How concerned, if at all, are you over the following forms of extremism?




Almost all groups, bar Labour voters, are more likely to be concerned by Islamist extremism than other forms




Labour is narrowly trusted on extremism over the Conservatives






